

Confirmation from compliance officer

An electrical installation company must have at least one compliance officer in its activities. The identity of this person/these persons is indicated in the company's self-audit scheme. One compliance officer must also be registered in the National Electrical Safety Board's register of companies, and the compliance officer must consent to this. Personal Data Processing

When you certify that you will be compliance officer for a certain company, the National Electrical Safety Board will store certain personal data about you.

The National Electrical Safety Board processes your personal data to be able to register the company at which you will be compliance officer. The National Electrical Safety Board may also use the data in the register in the exercise of its official authority.

Types of personal data that we process

In case of registration that you will be compliance officer for a certain company, we ask for your name and authorisation number (personal identity number).

How we use your personal data

When the company's registration is completed, the data are entered in the register of electrical installation companies which the National Electrical Safety Board has a duty to maintain under Article 27 of the Electrical Safety Ordinance (2017:218). Your confirmation will be filed and archived in accordance with applicable provisions regarding archiving and thinning.

Legal grounds

In order for the National Electrical Safety Board to process personal data, there must be legal grounds for the processing. The legal grounds for the relevant processing are provided in Article 6 1.e of the [Data Protection Regulation](#), namely that processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the National Electrical Safety Board.
